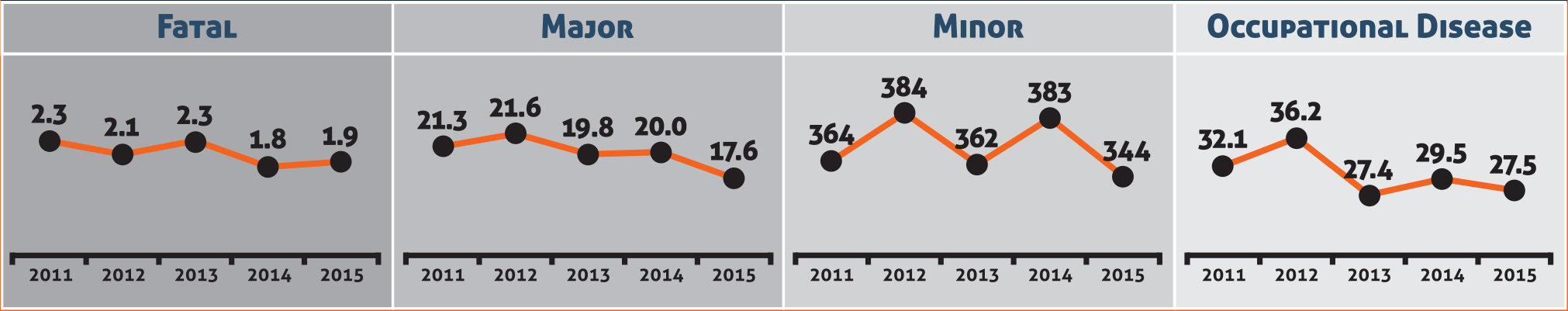


WORKPLACE SAFETY & HEALTH REPORT 2015

More fatalities but fewer non-fatal injuries at work in 2015

WORKPLACE INJURY RATES & OCCUPATIONAL DISEASE INCIDENCE AT A GLANCE (2011-2015)*



*per 100,000 employed persons

WORKPLACE INJURIES



66 workers were fatally injured, an annual rate of **1.9** per 100,000 employed persons



597 workers sustained workplace major injuries, an annual rate of **17.6** per 100,000 employed persons



685,379 man-days were lost, a rate of **85** man-days lost per million man-hours worked (i.e. accident severity rate)



11,688 workers sustained less severe injuries (i.e. minor injuries), an annual rate of **344** per 100,000 employed persons



1.5 incidents occurred for every million man-hours worked (i.e. accident frequency rate)

DANGEROUS OCCURRENCES (DO)



46 cases of DO were reported



22 Crane-related DO cases

OCCUPATIONAL DISEASE (OD)



935 OD cases were confirmed in 2015, an incidence rate of **27.5** per 100,000 employed persons



Leading OD was noise-induced deafness with **498** cases



Second most common OD was work-related musculoskeletal disorders (WRMSD) with **304** cases, with inclusion of back injury cases due to ergonomic risks
